

# Stun Tigers, 13-0

Holy Name and De La Salle were the main reasons for the Tiger losing its smack. After a scoreless first quarter the Saints drove 40 yards in five plays mid-way in the second period for their initial score.

The Crusader line play was so staunch that only once during the entire afternoon did the Bengals

Quarterback Schwaner dropped back and hit Picou with a pass that sent the latter into the end zone. The play covering 26 yards. On the extra point attempt Meyers picked up a bad snap from center and scooted into the promised land.

It was a blocked punt on the Tiger 13 in the third period that deflated Holy Cross and set up the second Aloysius touchdown.

Bang, bang, four plays later Schellhaas stumbled across from six yards out. Schwaner's placement was no good and the Crusaders led, 13-0.

Holy Cross' moment was brief but exciting although the Tigers didn't score. Starting from their own 16-yard line the Tigers moved to the Saints' three in eight plays. Johnny Brechtel's 33-yard pass to Don Leon featured the drive.

The Tigers also got as far as the Crusader 42 in the fourth quarter, but a bull-like St. Aloysius forward wall spoiled the drive.

Although the Tigers outgained the Saints in the statistics, they were hurt somewhat with first

stringers Joe Sciortino and John Williams sidelined.

The Bengals gained 152 yards on the ground and 82 in the air for a total of 234. Aloysius rushed for 105 and passed for 26 for a total of 131. In first downs the Crusaders led 10 to 6.

Halfback Norman Solis was best for the losers. Defensively Roy Deutschmann, Donald LeMay, Herbert Lacassange and Terrell Brunet stood out in the Tigs' line.
